## IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS)

March 16, 2020

Dear Still Waters family:

**Effective Wednesday, March 18 at the end of the day, Still Waters Adult Day Center will temporarily close both locations.** We plan to reopen on Monday, April 6.

This difficult decision was made after much discussion, thought and prayer. Although this will create hardships for some, we believe it is in the best interests of all parties concerned. A number of you have already decided to keep your loved one at home until the situation improves. We are also mindful of our staff members, many of whom have young children, elderly family members, or health conditions that make it problematic for them to report to work.

During the time the Centers are closed, we will organize work days at both locations to do extra cleaning and prepare for re-opening.

By April 1, we hope to have clarity about whether or not we will be able to resume operations on April 6. I will keep you informed.

I want to assure you that, to the best of our knowledge, no one who attends or works at either center has shown any signs of the virus. **We do not believe you or your loved one has been exposed to an active case of Coronavirus at Still Waters.**

While we are closed, please follow the guidelines provided by Governor Holcomb, Marion County Health Dept., and the CDC. Stay home as much as possible to limit exposure to other people, and practice good hygiene. **If you or anyone in your household develops symptoms or is tested or diagnosed with the COVID-19 virus, please contact us.** We are required to report any cases that may be linked to this location to the Marion County Health Department.

Thank you for the trust you have placed with us. Please keep Still Waters and all those who are part of this ministry in your prayers. I look forward to seeing you again soon.
